**CAMPUS SECURITY
AUTHORITIES (CSA)**

Four (4) Types:

- Campus Police or Security Department
- Individual/Organization who is identified as someone where a crime can be reported
- Official with "significant" responsibility for student and campus activities
- Official with authority and duty to respond to an issue

SLIDE SIX TRAINING SCRIPT

Criminals are dispersed and on those reported to Campus Security Authorities (CSAs). There are four categories of CSAs, as defined by the Clery Act:

- A campus police department or a campus security department of an institution.
- Any individual or organization specified in an institution's statement of campus security policy as one to which students and employees should report criminal offenses.
- An official of an institution who has significant responsibility for student and campus activities.

An official is defined as any person who has the authority and the duty to take action or respond to particular issues on behalf of the institution.
